19 - Word Problems (Easier)

Money Problems:

Q1. Stacey's mum writes the correct amount in words on a cheque: 'Seven Thousand, Eight Hundred and Two Pounds'
Write this as a number

Q2. Lizzy spends £56 on trainers and £97 on a coat. How much does she spend altogether?

Q3. Katie pays £36 for her two dogs and £85 for her 5 cats to enter a pet show. She wins £150 in prize money.

- a) How much does it cost for one dog to enter?
- b) How much does it cost for one cat to enter?
- c) How much profit does she make?

Q4. Joe's mum is buying a car for £9936. She pays a deposit of £993.60. How much does she still have to pay?

Q5. Deidre buys two packets of fish fingers at £1.35 each. If she pays with a £5 note, how much change will she receive?

Q6. The cost of using a mobile phone is 5p for every minute or part of a minute. Lee makes a 25 min 15 second call. How much does it cost?

Q7. Ian has £37.26 in coins. He changes them into £5 notes. How many £5 notes will he get and how much is left in coins?

Q8. Leah buys a pencil sharpener for 38p, a rubber for 45p and a pen for 74p. If she pays with a £2 coin, how much change will she receive?

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Measures Problems:

- Q1. Simon runs in a 500m race. After 3250m, he stops due to an injury. How far had he still to run?
- Q2. Gareth swims 400m in 7 minutes 8 seconds and the next 400m in 8 min 9 seconds. How long did it take to swim the 800m?
- Q3. A floor is 6m long and 4m wide. A carpet is put on the floor so that it is 1m from the edge of the room all around. What is the area of the carpet?
- Q4. Jim buys 3.8kg bag of potatoes. His mother also buys 6.3kg of potatoes. Altogether, what weight of potatoes have been bought?
- Q5. A jar of beetroot weighs 340g. With the vinegar removed it weighed 230g. How much did the vinegar weigh?
- Q6. Becky works in a restaurant. He weighs 83kg of flour. He uses half of it to make bread. How much in kg and g did he use for bread?
- Q7. A photo is 15cm wide and 10cm high. What is the area and perimeter of the photo?
- Q8. A telegraph pole is 10m long. 5.3m of it is cut off. What is the length of the remaining pole?
- Q9. A plane is travelling north-east. The pilot changes direction so as to travel north-west. Through how many degrees did he turn?

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Other Number Problems:

- Q1. In a packet, there are 120 tea bags. The packets are delivered to shops in boxes of 100 packets. How many tea bags are there in a box?
- Q2. A car park has 8 levels. On each level it is possible to park 214 cars. How many cars are in the car park when it is full?
- Q3. In every packet of buttons there are 85 buttons. Sam buys 4 packets. How many buttons has he bought?
- Q4. A garage replaces all the four tyres on a number of cars. During one day, they replaced 92 tyres. How many cars have had their tyres replaced?
- Q5. A container has 34 tea bags. Two packets each with 95 tea bags are opened and put into the container. How many tea bags are there in the container now?
- Q6. At midnight the temperature in my house is 16°C , but outside it is -3°C . What is the difference in temperature?
- Q7. One quarter of a box of sweets have been eaten. What fraction are left?
- Q8. In Year 5 there are 60 children. Three-quarters of them have school dinners. How many children is this?
- Q9. A farmer has 124 bales in one field and 116 in another. The bales are collected and stacked in eights. How many stacks of eight does the farmer make?
