

## Writing Composition

Choose one of the following to write about. Pay close attention to your spelling, punctuation and grammar. Use the lines printed on the exam paper for your writing.

### Either

1) “The Fire”

Write a story with this as your life. Concentrate on describing a fire and its effects, and your thoughts and feelings of the people involved, so that it is convincing to the reader.

### Or

2) Write a story about an occasion when you had to be responsible for someone else. This story could be imaginary, or based on a true event, but you need to make your writing vivid and convincing to the reader.

### Or

3) Write a story beginning ‘As I reached for the door-bell I had no idea what lay in store for me...’ Make sure that your story contains two main characters.
